II. AGENDA ITEMS

The agenda as printed was adopted.

A. Upon motion by Betsy Wester, seconded by Arlene Charles, the minutes from the April 19, 2018 meeting were approved unanimously.

B. Historic Preservation Commission to consider Certificate of Appropriateness as requested by First Baptist Church of Jonesboro for New Signage and Awning for the property located 126 S. Main Street, Fig Tree Café.

C. Historic Preservation Commission to consider Certificate of Appropriateness as requested by House of Dawn, for exterior modification to the property located 182 S. Main Street.
