

## **HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION**

- 1. Charles Cobb, representative for the First United Methodist Church, 142 South Main Street,** presented his case on behalf of said Church, to obtain a Certificate of Appropriateness. Mrs. Charles made a motion to accept the application with the stipulation that the building be painted in the same colors as another building on the premises. Mrs. Charles then rescinded said motion. Following rescinded motion, Mrs. Charles followed with a motion that the application for Certificate of Appropriateness as requested to demolish a block structure and replace with a new structure painted to match existing building on property, with paint samples to be delivered to Mr. Clark by October 18, 2016, and for landscaping improvements be approved. Mrs. Osborne seconded the motion. A vote was taken and approval was given.
- 2. Other Business:** On behalf of the City, Mr. Clark is applying for a Historic Preservation grant. As part of the process, he presented each of the Commission members with a Resume Form which he asked the members to complete and return to him no later than Oct. 21, 2016.
