REGULAR MEETING

- I. CALL TO ORDER The meeting was called to order by Karen at 6:03pm.
- II. ROLL CALL Helen, Jule, Trina, Karen, Tammary and Santia. Donya was absent.
- III. ADOPTION OF AGENDA Jule made the motion to adopt the agenda and Tammary seconded. The vote was unanimous.
- IV. ADOPTION OF MINUTES Tammary made the motion to adopt the minutes and Santia seconded. The vote was unanimous.
- V. FINANCIAL STATEMENTS Consideration of Financial Statements for 30-day period ending June 30th, 2024. Jule voted to accept the financials as presented by Andrew and Santia seconded. The vote was unanimous.

- 5. Box Truck. Andrew said that the box truck was the responsibility of Public Works even though the tables and chairs are regularly used for events.
